







Searches for FLY: Noun Verb Adjective

The noun fly has 5 senses (first 4 from tagged texts)

- (6) **fly** -- (two-winged insects characterized by active flight)
- (1) tent-fly, rainfly, fly sheet, **fly**, tent flap -- (flap consisting of a piece of canvas that can be drawn back to provide entrance to a tent)
- (1) **fly**, fly front -- (an opening in a garment that is closed by a zipper or by buttons concealed under a fold of cloth)
- (1) **fly**, fly ball -- ((baseball) a hit that flies up in the air)
- fly** -- (fisherman's lure consisting of a fishhook decorated to look like an insect)

The verb fly has 14 senses (first 9 from tagged texts)

- (33) **fly**, wing -- (travel through the air; be airborne; "Man cannot fly")
- (9) **fly** -- (move quickly or suddenly; "He flew about the place")
- (5) **fly**, aviate, pilot -- (fly a plane)
- (3) **fly** -- (transport by aeroplane; "We fly flowers from the Caribbean to North America")
- (2) **fly** -- (cause to fly or float; "fly a kite")
- (2) **fly** -- (be dispersed or disseminated; "Rumors and accusations are flying")
- (2) **fly** -- (change quickly from one emotional state to another; "fly into a rage")
- (1) **fly**, fell, vanish -- (pass away rapidly; "Time flies like an arrow"; "Time fleeing beneath him")
- (1) **fly** -- (travel in an airplane; "she is flying to Cincinnati tonight"; "Are we driving or flying?")
- fly** -- (display in the air or cause to float; "fly a kite"; "All nations fly their flags in front of the U.N.")
- flee, **fly**, take flight -- (run away quickly; "He threw down his gun and fled")
- fly** -- (travel over (an area of land or sea) in an aircraft; "Lindbergh was the first to fly the Atlantic")
- fly** -- (hit a fly)
- vanish, **fly**, vaporize -- (decrease rapidly and disappear; "the money vanished in las Vegas"; "all my stock assets have vaporized")

The adj fly has 1 sense (no senses from tagged texts)

- fly** -- ((British informal) not to be deceived or hoodwinked)
